

Communion Calls: Please call the parish office to arrange Communion calls for the home-bound.



Pastor's Corner

Dear brothers and sisters of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish,

For our Palm Sunday, I would share a poem/hymn by the fourth century scholar-deacon, Ephrem, who immersed himself deeply in scripture and the liturgical festivals of the Church.

Fair and eloquent flowers
have the children strewn before the King:
the donkey was garlanded with them,
the path was filled with them;
they scattered praises like flowers,
their songs of joy like lilies.
Now too at this festival
does the crowd of children scatter for you, Lord,
praises like blossoms.
Blessed is he who was acclaimed by young children.

It is as though our hearing embraced an armful of children's voices, while chaste songs, Lord, fill the bosoms of our ears.

Let each of us gather up a posy of such flowers, and with these let all intersperse blossoms from their own piece of land, so that, for this great feast, we may plait a great garland.

Blessed is he who invited us to plait it!

Let the chief pastor weave together his homilies like flowers, let the priests make a garland of their ministry, the deacons of their reading, strong young men of their jubilant shouts, children of their psalms, young women of their songs, chief citizens of their benefactions, ordinary folk of their manner of life.

Blessed is he who gave us so many opportunities for good.

Our students will be busy wrapping up their coursework, participating in the upcoming ILEARN, and starting up those spring sports and other extracurricular activities.

Our students and teachers have been practicing and preparing for the ILEARN assessment that will be administered the weeks of April 18, and 25, to students in grades 3-8. The ILEARN replaced ISTEP in 2019. This assessment is different from the ISTEP in that it is administered in a single testing window, it is untimed, and it is adaptive. Adaptive means the difficulty adjusts according to how questions are answered within the standard. The questions are presented in a different way, with students being asked to work through multiple-step problems and sometimes select more than one correct answer to a question. We look forward to the challenge of the ILEARN assessment and expect our students to do their very best.

Thank you to those parents who participated in our spring Parent/ Teacher Conferences. This was an opportunity to touch base with the teachers about the progress made throughout the year and the preparedness for the next grade level.

During Holy Week our students will once again present the Living Stations of the Cross on Good Friday, April 15 at 9 a.m. Each grade level has a part in this special prayer service. Parents and parishioners are welcome and encouraged to join us.



Roofing – new roofing material on two sections of the school and on the garage/handicap restroom have been delivered and replacement work has begun. They will continue work this week (weather pending).

Fence – the fence around the A/C units has been ordered and will be installed during the month of May.

Church bells – three of the five church bells are being repaired/electrified. Work to the bell hardware was completed on April $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$. They will return in the coming weeks to install a new control system.

Bids for Summer Project – we received a multitude of pricing for all of the different areas/projects on 3/11. The electrical documents went out to bidders last week (3/28) and we expect to have numbers back on 4/15. Once we have those prices, we will be able to determine which projects we expect to move forward with this summer.
