



# SCHOOL NEWS

During the 2022/2023 school year, Our Lady of Lourdes Lyons will be hearing the theme, "Here We Grow!" Already we are seeing signs of growth in the areas we emphasize through our school Vision. At OLL, our vision states that we are:

One Community, Living Faithfully, Leading Academically.

I witnessed one fabulous example of growth in community when I led a discussion with first graders. One student had been having a tough time with a concept, but then raised his hand to give an answer. The next classmate who raised his hand didn't want to give an answer, but he instead said, "I just wanted to say that he gave a really good answer."

There is an abundance of evidence in kindergarten of growth in faith, as these young students are learning more and more about how to pray. Each day their focus and participation in morning, afternoon, and meal time prayers increases.

Academically we just wrapped up our NWEA Map benchmark testing. The results of these tests in language arts, math, and science are the baseline by which we will measure academic growth during the weeks leading up through Christmas break. Our school year is well under way, and *Here We Grow!*

## **Autumn Adult Scripture Study**

Our Adult Scripture study for this autumn will be an exploration of the Book of Psalms. This book is a unique collection of the songprayers of Israel. To study Psalms is to study prayer, ultimately to enter into prayer. Participants will be led to reflect on their own prayer and life experiences. This study (the first of two) focuses on a selection of twenty-eight psalms divided into three categories: Psalms of descriptive praise, also known as hymns, praise God for his ongoing, regular care of the world and humanity. Psalms of trust or confidence reinforce the belief that the God who made and loves us will protect us in difficult situations. Wisdom Psalms are an acknowledgment of God's justice in the right ordering of human affairs. - Two sections of the study are offered: On Thursday mornings at 10 a.m., and in the evenings at 7:30 p.m., beginning September 29. 
