Pastor's Corner

Dear brothers and sisters of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish,

This weekend's gospel passage is one of the most beautiful and reassuring that Matthew the evangelist offers in his 28 chapters.

To quote: At that time Jesus exclaimed:

"I give praise to you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth,

for although you have hidden these things from the wise and the learned

you have revealed them to little ones.

Yes, Father, such has been your gracious will.

"All things have been handed over to me by my Father.

No one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son and anyone to whom the Son wishes to reveal him.

"Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest.

Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart; and you will find rest for yourselves. For my yoke is easy, and my burden light."

Revealed to little ones – folks of faith, young and old, who welcome God's truth, his steadfast love, his mercy.

Echoes of John's gospel "discourses" with his disciples, proclaiming *the closeness of the Father and the Son*.

The promise that living Jesus' "way", rather than the Pharisee's and Sadducee's religious burden, bringing them a relief and freedom they had heretofore known not.

How we receive these messages from Matthew 11:25-30 will vary from time to time. As always, the "moments" of our lives meld with God's Word to grant us insight and consolation.

May we find that each time we hear, read, or recall the wonder of Jesus' comforting words given over by all four evangelists.


