

Communion Calls: Please call the parish office to arrange Communion calls for the home-bound.



SCHOOL NEWS

School Days...memories of favorite teachers, old friends, and lessons learned. Many of those lasting lessons are likely not academic. Time at school provides the space to learn personal responsibility, social skills, understanding about those who are different from us, and how to take advantage of the opportunities offered us. In order for all types of learning to happen, the school environment must be a peaceful, joyful, orderly place in which to learn.

Managing student behaviors in most schools is very different from when Our Lady of Lourdes School first opened its doors. It's likely different from when our current parents attended school. This year we have put into place a behavior support system for the whole school that clearly defines expectations for a healthy learning environment.

Teachers each have their system for ensuring that students stay on task and focused on their work. If there are obstacles to learning that take more than several minutes away from instruction, then our assistant principal or principal helps address the situation. Students who need help managing their own behaviors are given tools to help address their needs, but are also held accountable in age appropriate ways for their actions.

We enjoy a community of teachers, staff, and parents who support all of the learning that happens at school. It is a true joy to experience the positive learning environment at OLL each day.




