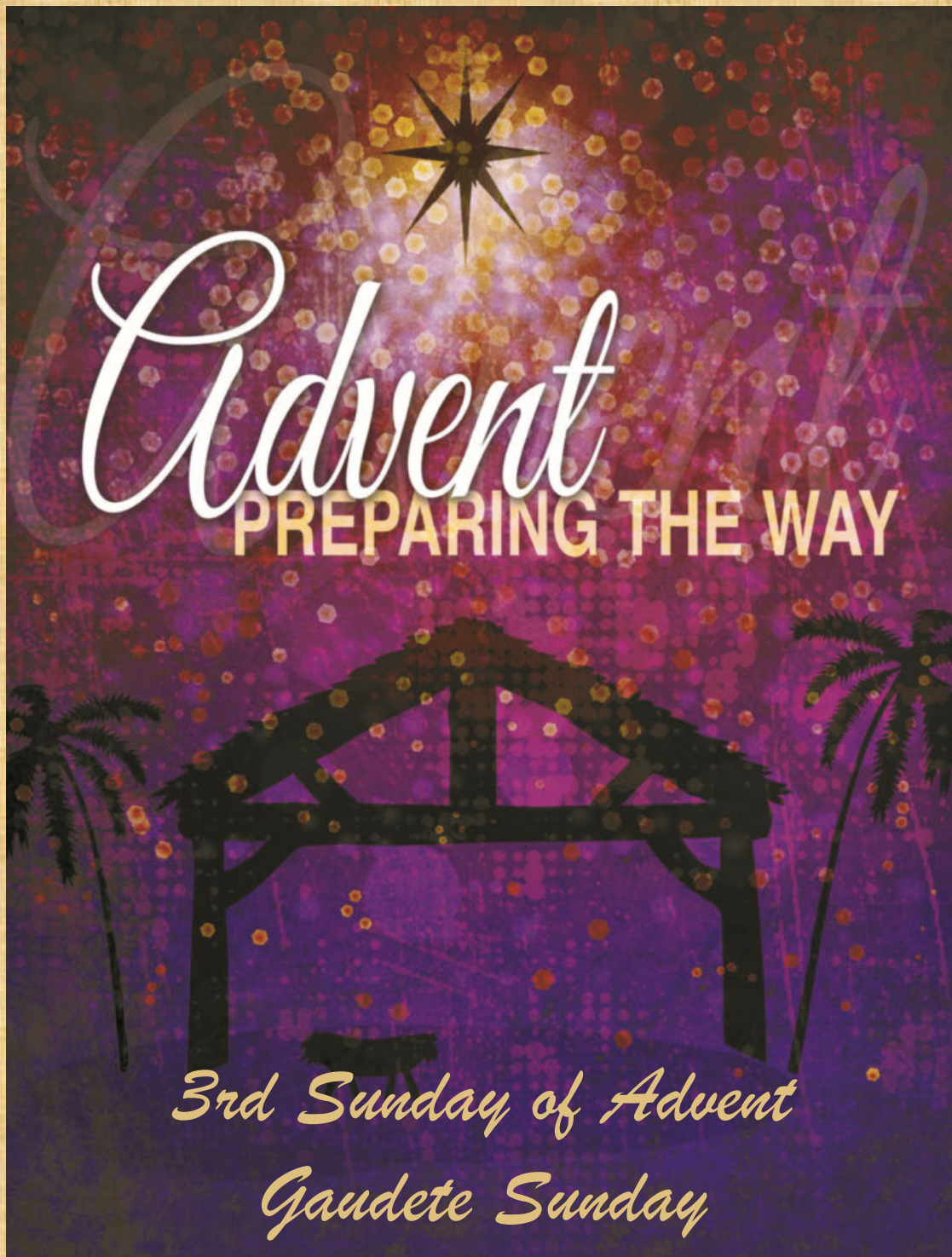

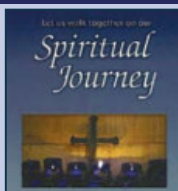

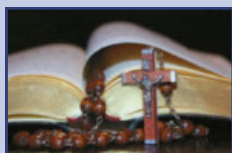

Pastor's Corner

My dear brothers and sisters of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish,

We are now in our third week of Advent. Today is Gaudete Sunday – that is, Rejoice! You may be familiar with a British university drinking song: “Gadeamus igitur, juvenes con sumus,” (We rejoice therefore, for we are youth!)”

We rejoice because our waiting is half over. We rejoice because we move from waiting for the Lord’s second coming and begin to prepare to celebrate his first coming.

There are times in our lives when it is apparent that we are not in touch with such waiting. We are not in touch with our longing for God. We are not seeking God in our lives.

Here is an Hasidic tale once told by Elie Wiesel, a survivor of the Nazi death camps. Perhaps we will all find wisdom here.

“Rebe Barukh’s grandson, Yehiel, came running into his study in tears. ‘Yehiel, Yehiel, why are you crying?’”

“‘My friend cheats! It’s unfair; he left me all by myself, that’s why I am crying.’”

“‘Would you like to tell me about it?’”

“‘Certainly, Grandfather. We played hide-and-seek, and it was my turn to hide and his turn to look for me. So, he gave up; he stopped looking. And that’s unfair.’”


“Rebbe Barukh began to caress Yehiel’s face, and tears welled up in his eyes. ‘God too, Yehiel’, he whispered softly. ‘God too is unhappy; he is hiding, and man is not looking for him. Do you understand, Yehiel? God is hiding and man is not even searching for him.’”

Isaiah the prophet, whom we hear much during our Advent Season, urged the people in Chapter 55:6-7:

“Seek the LORD while he may be found; call on him while he is near. Let the wicked forsake their ways and the unrighteous their thoughts. Let them turn to the LORD, and he will have mercy on them, and to our God, for he will freely pardon.”

Something to ponder this Third Week of Advent.

Advent, a calm, peaceful season of waiting. Most days, we have about 200 kids aged 3 -14 going about their business – and occasional funny business – during the school hours. Believe it or not, the peace of Advent is taking hold throughout the school.

One symbol from the Jesse Tree decorates each classroom and office space door. A walk through will reveal creative artwork and Bible passages related to these symbols of Jesus' ancestry. Each Monday morning, we gather as a whole school community in the gym for a short prayer reflection as we light successive candles on the Advent wreath. Students have been invited to share prayer intentions at a special location just outside the office. These intentions will be shared during morning announcements. There are many visual reminders of the season, such as Advent wreaths, paper candles in the windows, and teachers' personal decorative touches in the classrooms. During the third week, Mr. Ditzler is planning a Eucharistic Adoration hour. Watch for information coming soon about joining us.

As we do our best to stop, reflect, and feel the peace of this season of waiting, we hope you are able to do the same.

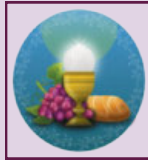

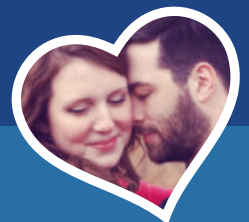

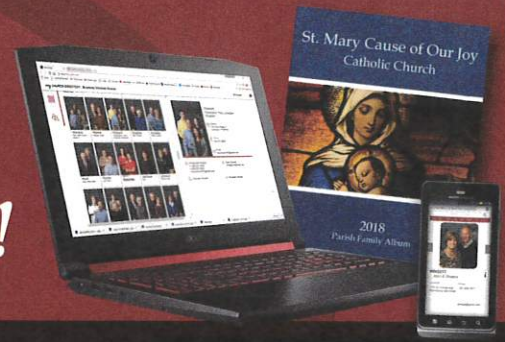
