

Communion Calls: Please call the parish office to arrange Communion calls for the home-bound.



Pastor's Corner

Dear brothers and sisters of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish,

Happy Epiphany! On this feast, the Lord is "made manifest", shown to us. For our ancestors, the Magi represented the Gentiles, non-Jews who were now included in covenant relationship (cf. Ephesians 2:15–16, 19–22).

In July 1993, I entered the University of Notre Dame summer program as a student. My first course was "The Liturgical Year". My professor was Father Robert Taft, S.J. He was a formidable presence with a kind heart. It was he who opened my eyes to the breadth of Catholicism's and Eastern Orthodoxy's (in communion with Rome) three approaches to epiphany.

For the Roman Catholic Church, the gospel on Epiphany is Matthew 2:1-12 – the story of the Magi.

For various Eastern Churches, the gospel on Epiphany is that of the Baptism of the Lord (Matthew, Mark, or Luke) – the manifestation of the Lord at the Jordan River.

For still other Eastern Churches, the gospel on Epiphany is the Wedding Feast of Cana (John 2:1-11) – the manifestation of Jesus through his first miracle (according to John).

This variety is telling. We are a Church with varied roots and customs. Together, we celebrate many "epiphanies".

Following the Second Vatican Council, the liturgical year calendar was revised. We now have all three gospels in a very short span. Matthew 2:1-12 on Epiphany (a Sunday or January 6); the Baptism of the Lord either the Sunday after Epiphany, or the day following Epiphany (this year, e.g.); and John 2:1-11 on January 7 weekdays, or the Second Sunday of the Year, Cycle C.

The following is a reflection by Saint Peter Chrysologus (5th Century) found in the Office of Readings for Epiphany. Enjoy the insights he provides to what we now have in the Church's liturgical calendar today!

N choosing to be born for us, God chose to be known by us. He therefore reveals himself in this way, in order that this great sacrament of his love may not be an occasion for us of great misunderstanding.

Today the magi find, crying in a manger, the one they have followed as he shone in the sky. Today the magi see clearly, in swaddling clothes, the one they have long awaited as he lay hidden among the stars.

Today the magi gaze in deep wonder at what they see: heaven on earth, earth in heaven, humanity in God, God in humanity, one whom the whole universe cannot contain now enclosed in a tiny body. As they look, they believe and do not question, as their symbolic gifts bear witness: incense for God, gold for a king, myrrh for one who is to die....

Today Christ enters the Jordan to wash away the sin of the world. John himself testifies that this is why he has come: Behold the Lamb of God, behold him who takes away the sins of the world....

Today Christ works the first of his signs from heaven by turning water into wine. But water [mixed with wine] has still to be changed into the sacrament of his blood, so that Christ may offer spiritual drink from the chalice of his body.
