Communion Calls: Please call the parish office to arrange Communion calls for the home-bound.



Pastor's Corner

My dear brothers and sisters of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish,

Alleluia! He is Risen, He is truly risen. Or in Greek, among our Eastern Orthodox fellow Christians: *Christos Anesti! Alithos Anesti!*

It is a joy to be able to sing full-throated "Alleluia" once again! And to bring to conclusion each Mass during Easter Week: Go in the Peace of Christ! Alleluia! Alleluia!

It would be sad to think that this joy could fade very quickly as we allow ourselves to sink once again into the daily routine of life's "same old, same old." But there is a way to avoid this sadness.

Saint Justin Martyr wrote in the second century an account describing the Christian weekly gathering on Sundays. He was attempting to help unbelievers to grasp why Christians believe what they believe and live the way they live rooted in that belief.

"It is on Sunday that we all assemble because Sunday is the first day: the day on which God transformed darkness and matter and created the word, and the day on which Jesus Christ our Savior rose from the dead. He was crucified on the eve of Saturn's day, and on the day after, that is, on the day of the sun, he appeared to his apostles and disciples and taught them what we have now offered for your examination."

We are believers, my brothers and sisters! Each Sunday is a remembrance and celebration of Easter joy no matter the season. Our joy need not fade! We can renew it, together. And then go forth to touch the world with the power of the Risen One -- that is, his love and compassion which raises all so touched from the little daily deaths we all know.

And so: Alleluia! He is Risen, He is truly risen! As these marvelous words echo in our hearts, let us plan to gather each week with God's assembly of believers! Let us continue to be renewed in Christ!


