

Communion Calls: Please call the parish office to arrange Communion calls for the home-bound.



### Pastor's Corner

My dear brothers and sisters of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish,

In the summer of 2013, several folks from the Archdiocese of Indianapolis traveled to Rome on the "Pallium Pilgrimage." Archbishop Tobin was to receive the pallium from Pope Francis while we were there. I was privileged to be among the group.

We did not spend all our time in Rome. We traveled to other nearby parts of Italy. One such day trip was to Orvieto. Once arrived, we entered the Cathedral – not knowing that it is a significant place in the development of the Feast of Corpus Christi!

For in the Cathedral, in a side chapel area to the left of the main sanctuary, there is a corporal encased in glass upon which a newly consecrated host bled.

We were told by our guide that in 1263, a German priest, Fr. Peter of Prague, was on pilgrimage to Rome. The priest, though pious, struggled to believe in the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist. While he was celebrating Mass in the Church of St. Christina in Bolsena, having just finished the words of consecration, blood began to seep from the Host onto the altar and corporal (a special linen square upon which the precious eucharistic elements rest during Mass).

Fr. Peter immediately journeyed to Orvieto where Pope Urban IV was residing at the time. He informed the pontiff of what had just occurred.

Pope Urban had the host and blood-stained corporal brought to the Cathedral in Orvieto. They are still venerated there to this day.

Pope Urban instituted the feast of "Corpus Christi" a year later, 11 August 1264, with the publication of the papal bull *Transiturus*.

For the celebration, the Pope asked one of the great theologian St Thomas Aquinas — who at that time was accompanying the Pope and was in Orvieto — to compose the texts of the Liturgical Office for this great feast. They are masterpieces, still in use in the Church today, in which theology and poetry are fused. These texts include such famous hymns as the *Pange lingua, Tantum ergo*, and *Panis Angelicus*. They are expressions of praise and gratitude for the Most Holy Sacrament. They penetrate the mystery with wonder, recognizing in the Eucharist the Living and Real Presence of Jesus while noting his reconciling sacrifice of and brings salvation.

It required several years for this Feast to truly become universally observed. Today we celebrate this Feast annually, two weeks after Pentecost, and one week after Trinity Sunday.

In this year when we approach the National Eucharistic Congress, may we celebrate with greater joy and passion for this greatest of gifts of God's presence in Christ!
