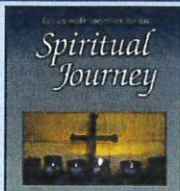

Pastor's Corner

Dear brothers and sisters of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish,

Last week I was able to spend 3 days with my brother priests and Archbishop Thompson at St. Meinrad. It was our annual Convocation of Priests, literally "a calling together".

This annual event is always rich with learning content, daily Mass, free afternoons for recreation of all sorts, and evenings of prayer, adoration, confessions. The last evening is given over to a banquet at which we honor newly ordained, retirees, and jubilarians.

This year we welcomed the three newly ordained, praised and thanked 1 retiree, and gave thanks for 25, 50, 60 and 70(!) year jubilarians.

St. Meinrad is a Benedictine monastery located in Spencer County. The monks are a part of the Swiss Federation, founded from Our Lady of Einsiedeln Abbey in Einsiedeln, Switzerland. The first monks arrived in Indiana in 1854. The first school was established in 1857. Since then, thousands of priests have emerged from the school. Almost all the native priests of our Archdiocese have been educated in whole or in part at St. Meinrad. The place is literally a "second home" for us!

I am thankful for this annual opportunity to have time to pray, eat, and share time with my brother priests. It is a high point for which I look forward each June.

The Feast of St. Benedict is this Thursday, July 11. Please join me for the 6 p.m. Mass to give praise and thanks to God for this great saint, the founder of Western Monasticism and a source of great wisdom.

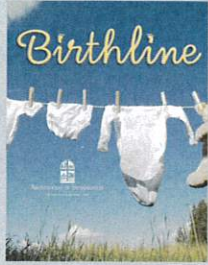
