



Pastor's Corner

My dear brothers and sisters of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish,

It's that time of year when the "post Halloween Festival" events begin to unfold in our community.

The annual Irvington Community Thanksgiving Meal once again is being hosted by Our Lady of Lourdes. We are not alone in this outreach, as folks from our neighborhood and neighboring churches of the Irvington Association of Ministers make this a community effort.

SCHOOL NEWS

Reading. It's all over the news this year as schools adjust to the new laws related to the standardized third grade reading test known as I-READ 3. In March, our second and third grade classes will take this test. If a student passes this test in second grade, then the requirement has been met, and this student will not be required to take the test in third grade. The second grade testing report will indicate if the student is on track to pass the test by the end of third grade. If they do not pass the test of basic reading skills in March, students in third grade will have opportunities to retake the test in spring and summer.

Our Lady of Lourdes School provides excellent instruction in the classroom. For those who may need more support, we also provide extra differentiated reading instruction through our reading interventionist program, our resource/special ed program, Title I tutoring, and English as Second Language tutoring. At home, the more your children read, the more parents and grandparents read, the more the adults read to the children (no matter how old the children are), the better at reading our students become. As always, thanks for all you do to support our teaching!






Please Help with Sunday Religious Ed


