

Pastor's Corner

My dear brothers and sisters of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish,

It's February, the longest month of the year! As the cold and gray continue, it is easy for us to hunker down into being comfortable. At the same time, we often lose focus on what, beyond comfort, is life-giving, even sustaining.

Personal discipline is one such focus so diminished. Whether it is exercise, healthy eating, prayer, reading scripture – the cold and gray tends to isolate us at home, drawing over our lives drapes of inactivity.

I was reminded of this by the first reading from Hebrews 12:4-7, 11-15, on Wednesday, the Memorial of Saint Agatha,

Brothers and sisters:

In your struggle against sin

you have not yet resisted to the point of shedding blood. You have also forgotten the exhortation addressed to you as children:

My son, do not disdain the discipline of the Lord or lose heart when reproved by him; for whom the Lord loves, he disciplines; he scourges every son he acknowledges.

Endure your trials as "discipline;"

God treats you as his sons.

For what "son" is there whom his father does not discipline? At the time, all discipline seems a cause not for joy but for pain, yet later it brings the peaceful fruit of righteousness to those who are trained by it.

So strengthen your drooping hands and your weak knees.

Make straight paths for your feet,

that what is lame may not be dislocated but healed.

Strive for peace with everyone,

and for that holiness without which no one will see the Lord.

See to it that no one be deprived of the grace of God,

that no bitter root spring up and cause trouble,

through which many may become defiled.

I invite us all to consider this wisdom for our entire self – mental, physical, spiritual. May we become stronger in all three through discipline.

SCHOOL NEWS

Many people within our school and parish community are familiar with our school's Vision Statement: One Community. Living Faithfully. Leading Academically. School staff work hard to make sure that this is a living vision and not something to simply be repeated by rote each day. It's gratifying to witness examples of learning in all of these areas during day-to -day school life. Here are examples:

- Our students raised \$341 to aid victims of California
- Two first graders came upon Mrs. Page's misplaced and unattended prize bag. They went to find her and report her bag as found saying, "And we didn't take anything out even though it was really, really hard."
- The teachers and eighth-graders took the annual volleyball game to a very close three game finish, won by the eighth grade. It was competitive, loud, fun, and 100% marked by superb sportsmanship.
- Upon a teacher's return from a long illness, a second grade boy remarked, "I'm so glad to see you because I was praying for you every day!"
- A young man asked his reading support teacher what he would be reading next. When she told him, he replied, "That's a good one because I will be able to use my background knowledge."
- A group of fifth, sixth, and seventh-graders were tour guides for prospective families at our school open house. They were roundly complimented over and over for their politeness, conversation, information, and leadership.
- A sixth grade boy was helping to raise the flag early in the morning. While he was awaiting his friends, he asked his science teacher about the possibility of measuring sound waves for frequency and amplitude.

Thank you for the foundation you set that helps us teach our students well.
