



My dear brothers and sisters of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish,

'Tis spring! The early morning birds sing and then go quiet as the dawn intrudes upon their music.

'Tis spring! The buds are bursting forth, the grass greening, the earth softening, the yellow and purple early flowers are pushing through and standing over the softened earth.

'Tis spring! Ramadan is ending. Passover approaching. And Holy Week will soon erupt and flow inexorably into Paschal Joy.

All this suggests a beloved Easter hymn.
