



### Pastor's Corner

Dear brothers and sisters of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish,

In his book "The God of Mercy," Pope Francis spoke of his sense of wretchedness. This was not a demeaning of his self or his goodness as a creature of God, but rather an admission that he was a sinner.

He continued, only when one accepts one's sinfulness and, because of that, one's wretchedness, can one truly accept a need for divine mercy. And that divine mercy is the embodiment at that moment of being overwhelmed by the love God has for us.

This Sunday's gospel relates Peter's reaction to Jesus' question: Do you love me? The question is posed three times. The response grows in intensity, welling up from a heart wounded by the repetition.

Recall that Peter denied knowing the Lord three times earlier in the courtyard. But Jesus does not demean Peter with guilt and shame; Peter already experienced those the moment his third denial passed his lips. Rather, Jesus takes this imperfect human being and commissions him to tend and feed the flock of the assembly of believers.

For any of us to estimate that the Vicar of Christ, the Pope, to be any greater as a human being than anyone else is close to idolatry. All are sinners. All are redeemed in Christ. All are called, imperfect as one is, to mission of the values that Jesus witnessed to and taught.

With the conclave of cardinals in process, it is ours as fellow sinners to pray for the electors to seek God's mercy and the Spirit's life-giving breath as they speak, listen, deliberate, and choose the next Vicar of Christ.

Whoever emerges on the balcony of St. Peter's basilica, it is ours as fellow sinner to pray for him, as the Church always does, daily with a special devotion.

Let us never forget that those who lead, especially in the Church, come from among a sea of redeemed sinners who humbly seek God's care, love, and mercy.
