

Pastor's Corner

My dear brothers and sisters of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish,

The adage goes: the only constant in life is change. Changing time. Changing tastes. Changing clothes. Changing focus or priorities. Life changes.

We are on the cusp of a life change, both mine and yours.

For me, from full-time pastoral ministry to retirement -- yet with ministry, just less of it. And more control of my calendar.

For you, from one pastor to sharing a pastor. Our Lady of Lourdes and the former St. Bernadette knows what the latter is like – you did it for several years.

One of the changes which comes with a shared pastor is how to make the Mass schedule, both weekday and weekend, work for the pastor and the communities.

The Mass schedule decision was a collaborative effort among Fathers Jude, Bob and me, as well as the staffs and parish pastoral councils.

On July 1, 2025, the new weekday Mass schedule will begin. Note: at OLL on July 2, and at LF on July 3. *No Mass at LF on Tuesday, July 1*.

Weekdays: Tuesday - Friday there will be Mass alternating between parishes.

Tuesday: 8:30 a.m. at Little Flower.

Wednesday: 8:30 a.m. at Our Lady of Lourdes.

Thursday: 5:30 p.m. at Little Flower. Friday: 5:30 p.m. at Our Lady of Lourdes.

Weekends: The Archdiocese, after several years of experience and consultation, has a policy that a priest should be limited to 4 parochial Masses per weekend. In my experience in Terre Haute, that worked well. Both parishes went from 3 Masses per weekend to 2 per weekend. Yes, there were weekends with a Wedding with Mass or a Funeral with Mass. When this occurred, I tried to have a priest cover one or more of the weekend Masses when possible.

The new weekend schedule will begin July 5-6.

Saturday: 4:00 p.m. at Our Lady of Lourdes,

5:30 p.m. at Little Flower

Sunday: 9:00 a.m. at Little Flower, 11:00 a.m. at Our Lady of Lourdes, and 6:00 p.m. at Little Flower (with a later decision after consultation if this can continue.)

Confessions:

Our Lady of Lourdes – Saturday, 3:30 p.m.;

Little Flower – Thursday. 5:00 p.m.

Holyday Masses: One anticipation, two school Masses on the day, one evening Mass on the day. *Location of the Anticipation and Evening holyday Masses will be discussed in the first week of July when Father Jude arrives*.

May God bless us in these days of change!

Travel-size toothpastes, lotions, and shampoos Disposable razors


