



Pastor's Corner

Dear brothers and sisters of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish:

One of the resources for our prayer leading to or following upon our sharing in the Sacrament of Reconciliation are the Penitential Psalms.

There are seven: 6, 32, 38, 51, 102, 130, and 143. Each is unique, yet they share the acknowledgement of sin, guilt, and the need for God's assured mercy.

We hear Psalm 51 often during the Season of Lent. It also prayed during Morning Prayer (Liturgy of the Hours) every Friday.

Because Psalm 51 is so central to our Season; because this coming Wednesday evening a Penance Service will be offered at Little Flower, here is the text of this psalm for our use in prayer.

> Have mercy on me, God, in your kindness. In your compassion blot out my offense. O wash me more and more from my guilt and cleanse me from my sin.

My offenses truly I know them; my sin is always before me. Against you, you alone, have I sinned; what is evil in your sight I have done.

That you may be justified when you give sentence and be without reproach when you judge, O see, in guilt I was born, a sinner was I conceived.

Indeed you love truth in the heart; then in the secret of my heart teach me wisdom. O purify me, then I shall be clean; O wash me, I shall be whiter than snow.

Make me hear rejoicing and gladness that the bones you have crushed may revive. From my sins turn away your face and blot out all my guilt.

A pure heart create for me, O God, put a steadfast spirit within me. Do not cast me away from your presence, nor deprive me of your holy spirit.

Give me again the joy of your help; with a spirit of fervor sustain me, that I may teach transgressors your ways and sinners may return to you.

O rescue me, God, my helper, and my tongue shall ring out your goodness. O Lord, open my lips and my mouth shall declare your praise.


For in sacrifice you take no delight, burnt offering from me you would refuse; my sacrifice, a contrite spirit, a humbled, contrite heart you will not spurn.

SCHOOL NEWS

Dear OLL Families,

This week we celebrated Disability Awareness Week at Our Lady of Lourdes. Each year, the school partners with the Joseph Maley Foundation to present lessons to our K-8 students about people who live with a variety of disabilities. The lessons give our students a greater appreciation for differences, but also demonstrate the human potential for success despite difficulties.

We have made it to the end of the 3rd Quarter of the school year. Your access to Jupiter for grade viewing was closed on Friday after school and will reopen on Wednesday, March 16 for Report Card day. Your child's grade should never come as a surprise to you. Please be sure to continue to check Jupiter on a regular basis to monitor grades and attendance. If you have any questions about a particular grade or class, please be sure to contact your child's teacher.

On that note, our teachers will be conducting a second round of Parent/Teacher Conferences, but due to the timing of Easter and consequently Spring Break, these will take place on Thursday, April 7, instead of next week. It is beneficial to speak to the teachers about your child's progress in the spring. This is an opportunity to discuss the year's achievements and any concerns moving forward to the next grade level. OLL will begin processing School Choice voucher applications once we have our tuition rates for next year finalized. We are getting closer and will notify families when we are ready. Families who feel they qualify for a voucher will meet with Mrs. Bakemeyer, the parish Business Manager, to complete the application process. If you have any questions about whether or not you may qualify for a voucher, please feel free to contact me or Mrs. Bakemeyer. Also, families may apply for financial aid through FACTS now and for tax credit scholarships (SGO) on April 1.

We will be celebrating St. Patrick's Day on Thursday, March 17, with a "wear green" dress out day. Our 5th grade students will go downtown to march in the St. Patrick's Day Parade, so we hope for nice weather. This years' 6th and 7th grade students are welcome to march with our 5th graders because they never had the chance due to parade cancellations.

We continue to celebrate Lent through acts of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Please don't forget that you are welcome to join us for Stations of the Cross after every school Mass during Lent. Also, encourage your children to earn some extra cash through chores or service so they can donate their own funds to Operation Rice Bowl.


