

Communion Calls: Please call the parish office to arrange Communion calls for the home-bound.



SCHOOL NEWS

Buddy: a companion.

Buddy up: to become friendly and work closely together.

These are dictionary definitions, but they mean so much more when we see our Mass Buddy system at work. Every student in grades 4 through 8 has a younger buddy. Before Mass, the older students pick up the younger ones to walk over to church. During Mass, these pairs or small groups sit together. After Mass, they walk back over to the school building together before going back to their respective classrooms.

Seeing this system in action is to witness the Gospels in action. Older students help younger students zip coats and remind them to quiet themselves as they enter the church. Upper grade buddies give guidance to youngsters to help them bless themselves with holy water and genuflect as they find their pews. Older kids share hymnals and point out difficult words or musical beats to their young buddies. Big kids shepherd the smallest children forward during Communion to receive their blessings and then help them back to their pews.

Anyone attending our all-school Mass will notice these companions working closely together as Mass Buddies. What a great reminder to us all of how the friend we have in Jesus works among us!


