

Our Lady of Lourdes offers preschool and kindergarten through 8th grade classes. Please call the School Office for more information at 317-357-3316.



Pastor's Corner

My dear brothers and sisters of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish,

As we enter the month of June with its warmer temperatures and greenery dotted randomly and many colored flowers proudly waving in the breezes, all of this burgeoning life seems in stark contrast to two folks in my life.

You all know Father Larry Richardt, my long-time best friend. As a retired priest he has continued to serve many – as a guest presider and preacher, confessor, and spiritual director. His love of God, God's creation and God's people has always been evident. At 87 years old, he has remained vital until recently.

In the past three weeks he has been diagnosed with cancer – mandibular (jawbone), duodenal (upper intestine), and possible lung or lymph cancer. Having three cancers erupt at once has placed him at stage 4, incurable and questionably treatable. As of this writing, the final prognosis is pending.

Please keep Father Larry, his family, and his many friends in your prayers. As we all shall one day be, he is on his journey home to the Lord.

Tuesday, May 20, Dr. Scott Alan Lintner, the surgeon who repaired my rotator cuff, died after a long battle with skin cancer. He was not only skilled as a surgeon, but a good human being, vitally interested in helping his patients, and connected deeply to family, colleagues and friends. His good friend and colleague, Dr. Tim Hupfer, has taken over the care of some of Dr. Lintner's patients, me included. Dr. Hupfer is the surgeon who rotated my torn meniscus in 2021; I welcome his willingness, even as he mourns the loss of his friend.

Please keep the family and colleagues in your prayers.
