

Pastor's Corner

My dear brothers and sisters of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish,

It is hot and steamy here at St. Meinrad! In fact, hanging a wrinkled alb hung outside soon found relaxation! Holding arthritic hands out to the side and to the sun soothed aching joints! And being at home once again where my pastoral and priestly life finds deep roots allowed for a great solace.

Today, Tuesday, I was asked to preside at the daily Convocation Mass. We gathered in St. Thomas Aquinas chapel on the Feast of the Birth of John the Baptist: priests of the archdiocese, and priests from various countries serving in the archdiocese. Father Bob Gilday preached a good homily. We were quite a duo from the Eastside!

I first stepped into this same chapel 63 years ago during Vocations Week (basically, seminary summer camp). In those days, the windows were open, the air filled with humidity and aromas from the Abbey farm. Boys from 6th through 8th grade filled the pews. Here we prayed as one, here we were touched by Benedictine prayer and hospitality. And here some priestly vocations emerged.

I had never presided at Mass in this chapel/womb. Prayed many times here, yes, over those 63 years. Sung many, many times – no surprise! Witnessed the Spirit flow through the Word, Sacrament, and the many priests who ministered to the community of faith gathered for a time.

It was a distinct honor to stand in the sanctuary, addressing my brother priests and Archbishop Thompson as principal celebrant. It was a humbling experience. It awakened the memories of this place, the monks, schoolmates and brother priests. It connected a beginning to an ending.

We are all going through an ending at this time. We are all affected by it, alternating from joy to loss to anxiety. We share a common moment in life.

This Wednesday morning, July 2, I will stand in the sanctuary of the Chapel/Mary Chapel/Berandette Chapel for the last time as pastor of this community of believers. Our life together began in this place, and will end in this place. But our life in Christ continues. May we all be faithful to this life, and come at last to the Heavenly Banquet with all the Saints!
